# NUM-App – Short Introduction

## What is it about?

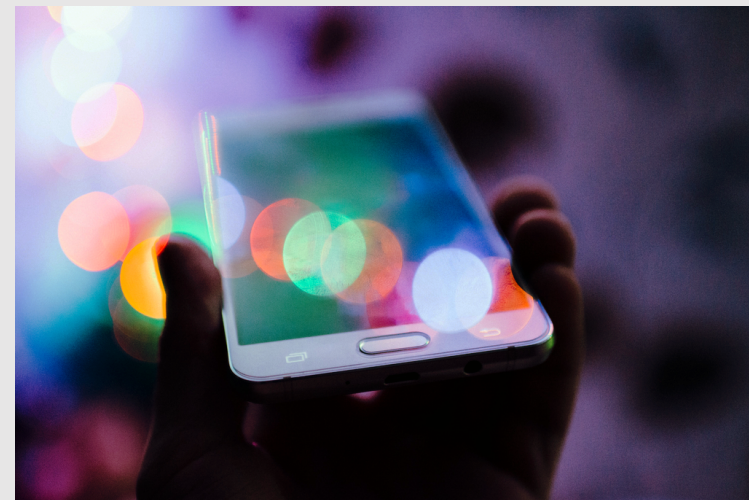
The app provides a quick and easy way to digitally conduct questionnaire-based studies. Study participants can fill out (FHIR) questionnaires on their mobile device and submit them when done. The study staff can easily retrieve submitted responses and changed questionnaires without the need for participants to reinstall the mobile app.

## What about data protection?

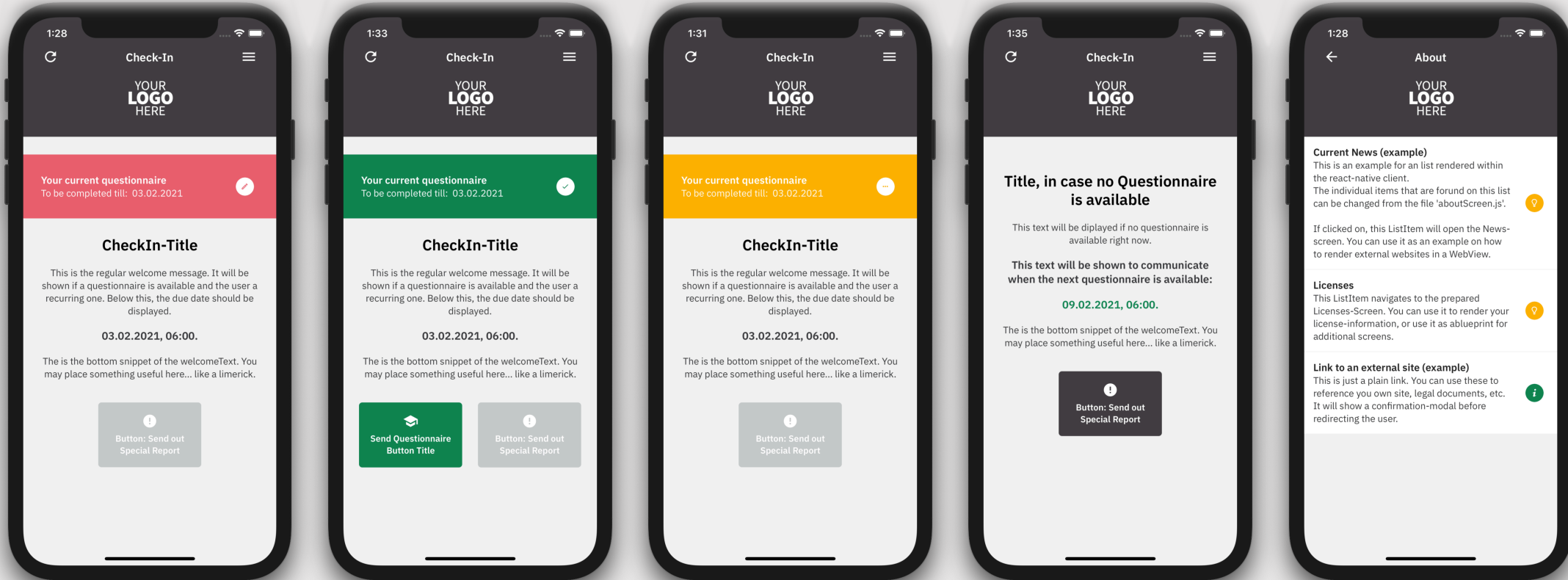
Questionnaire responses are always end-to-end encrypted which enables the use of the num-app for medical studies.

## Advantages of the open-source app

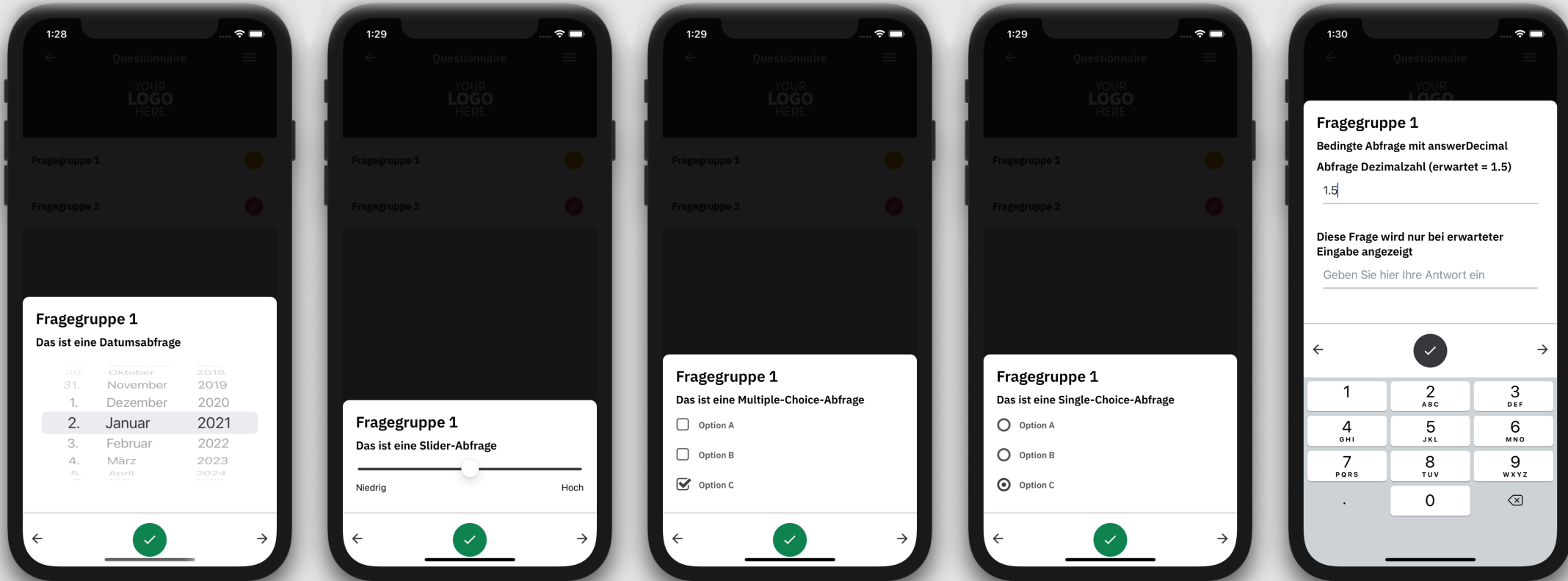
The app is easily customizable and can be adapted to individual requirements. Setup is also very quick. As it is open-source, everybody can add new features!

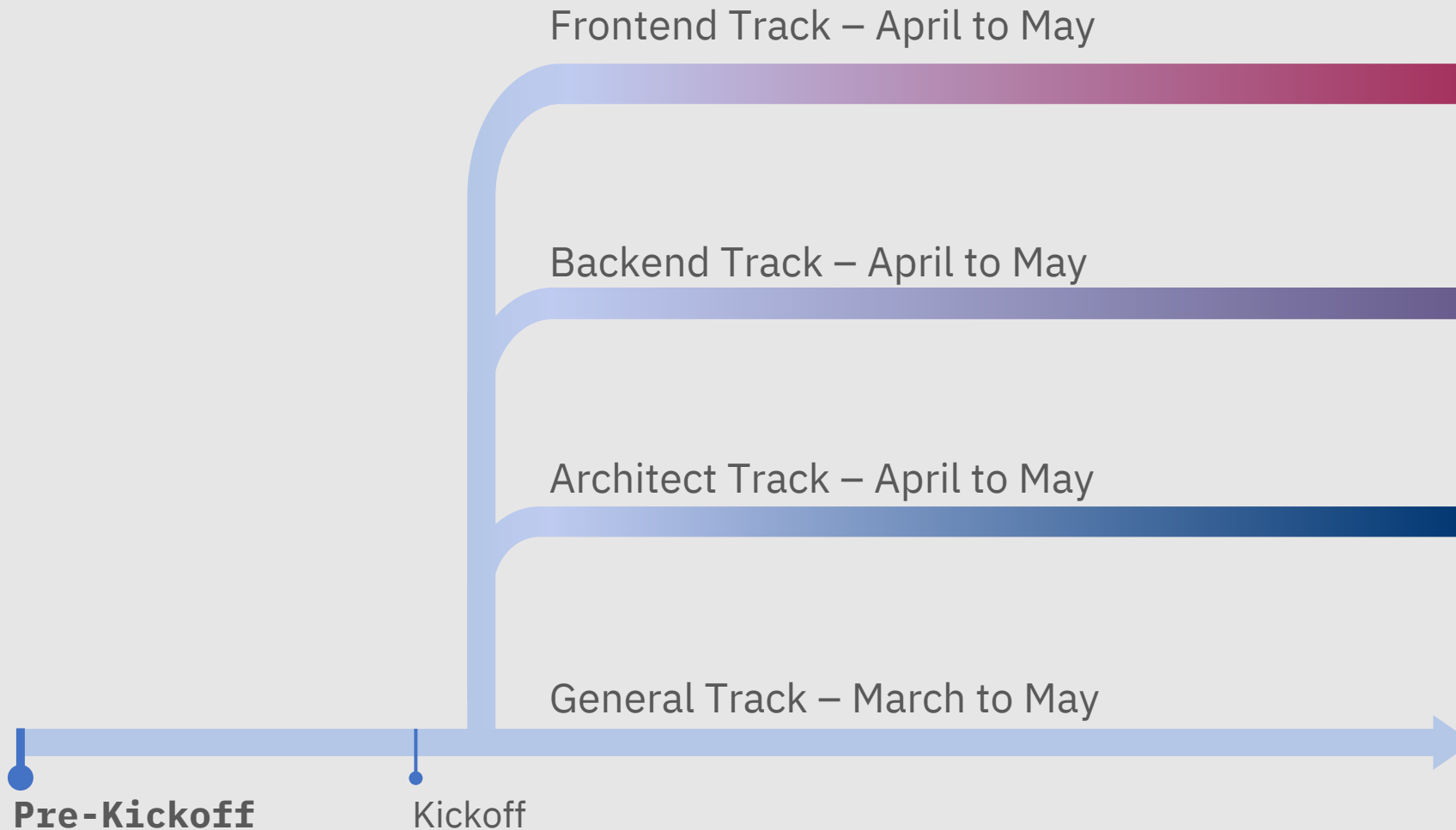

# Who can Join?

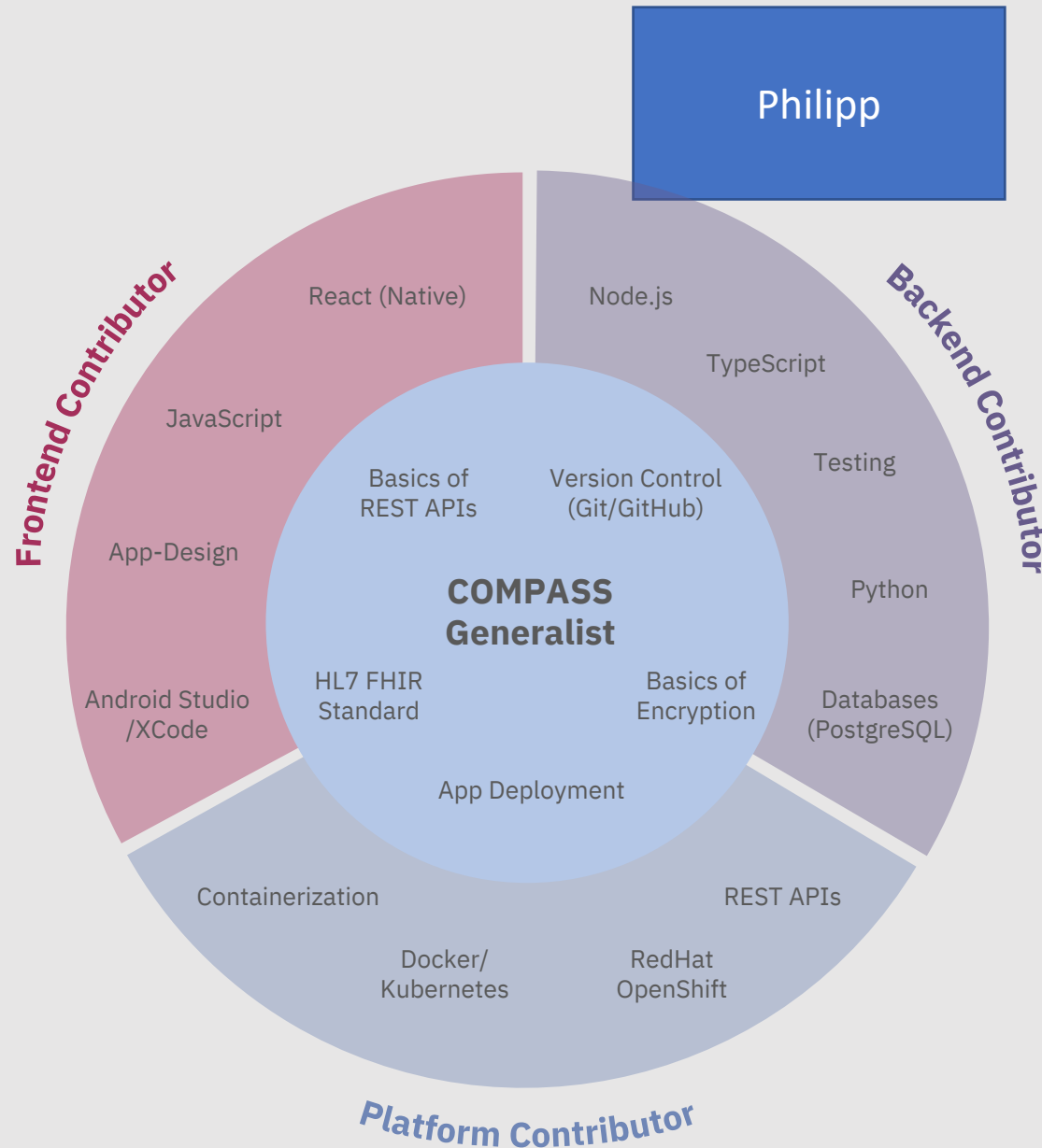
Everyone interested is welcome to participate in the **NUM COMPASS Open-Source project!**
